# Strawberry Sunbutter Bites

#### **Ingredients**

2 large flour tortillas4-6 tablespoons SunButter10 strawberries, thinly sliced

#### **Preparation**

- 1. Place the tortillas on a flat surface and spread each with 2-3 tablespoons sunbutter.
- 2. Divide the strawberries between the wraps and tightly roll up pressing the edge of the tortilla with sunbutter to adhere.
- 3. Place the wrap seam side down on a cutting board and cut into 1 inch wheels.
